



## Themes and Activities

### **Week 1 ~ Join the Coast Guard**

*Students kick off the summer by learning all about water safety and laws protecting the beach and surrounding oceans. Join the Coast Guard and find out how to protect people living and playing by the ocean through mock incident scenarios and role playing. Students have the chance to learn everything there is to know about being safe on the water.*

### **Week 2 ~ A Ticket to Ride**

*This week students learn all about different vehicles of transportation from bicycles all the way up to commercial airliners. While learning about the different vehicles we will also look at the infrastructure systems that allow us all to use these modes of transportation to travel domestically and internationally.*

### **Week 3 ~ Beautiful Blossoms**

*Students study not only different varieties of flowers but also the different parts of a flower and their function in detail. Take a look at the organic processes of pollination and photosynthesis while learning about the life cycles of flowers found both locally in Japan and exotic flowers from around the world.*

### **Week 4 ~ Forces of Physics**

*Students will have the opportunity to explore the science of physics by conducting simple and safe experiments with gravity, magnetism and momentum. Through these experiments students will gain a better understanding of how things react around them in the physical world.*

### **Week 5 ~ A Peek at the Polar Caps**

*Students have the rare chance to take a closer look at Earth's most distant ecosystem; the polar ice caps. Throughout this week we will study all about the environment in this delicate yet very important habitat. Time to play with the penguins.*

### **Week 6 ~ Camp Soleil**

*Time to take a camping trip in English to learn all about camping equipment and camping activities. Learn a little bit about survival techniques and how to set up a good campsite. Students can learn how to set up camp, play outdoor games and make camping snacks.*

### **Week 7 ~ Interesting Insects**

*Students spend a week learning about the fundamental anatomy of insects as well as different species of insect. Examine what insects can be found locally and discuss insects found in other countries, but not in Japan.*
